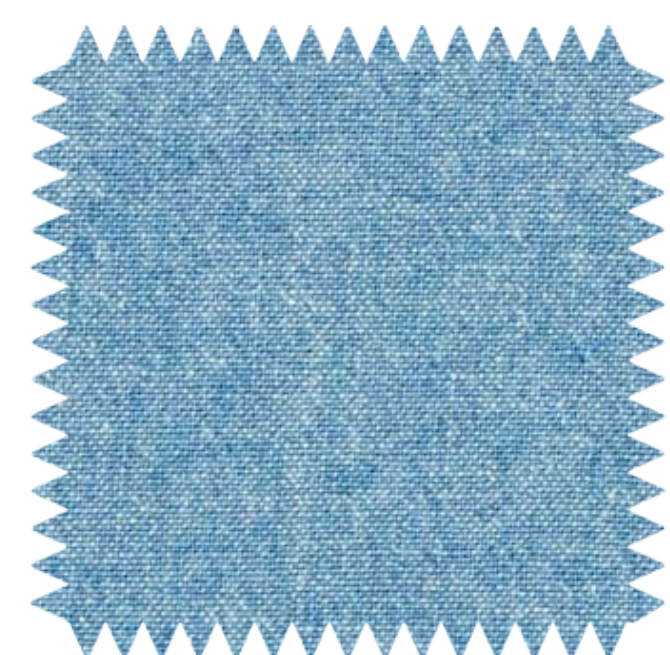


MATERIALS



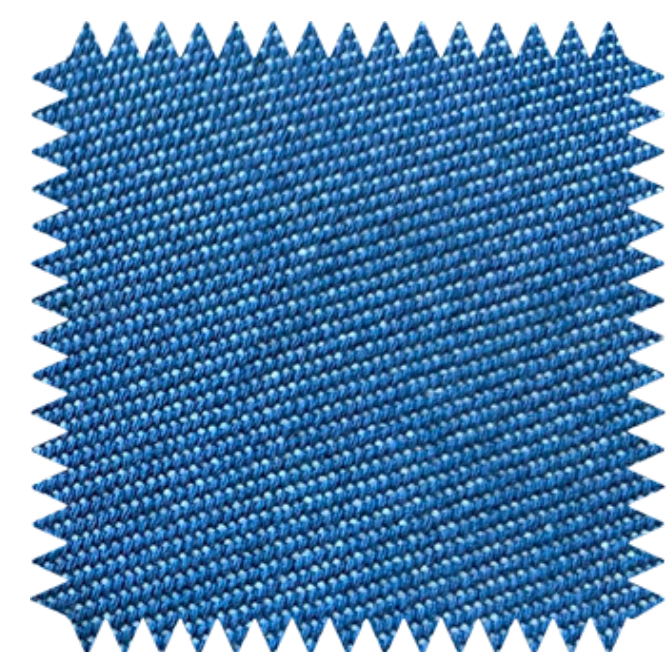
HEMP

A renewable plant-based fibre that can help create a greener future. Hemp is fast-growing, biodegradable, and doesn't require pesticides, herbicides, or chemical fertilisers to thrive. It yields a highly durable fabric that breathes well and is machine washable.



ORGANIC COTTON

A natural fibre that grows in harmony with nature and without chemical fertilisers. Organic cotton is produced via a holistic process that uses less water and energy than conventionally grown cotton, it increases soil quality and biodiversity, and results in a light wearable fibre.



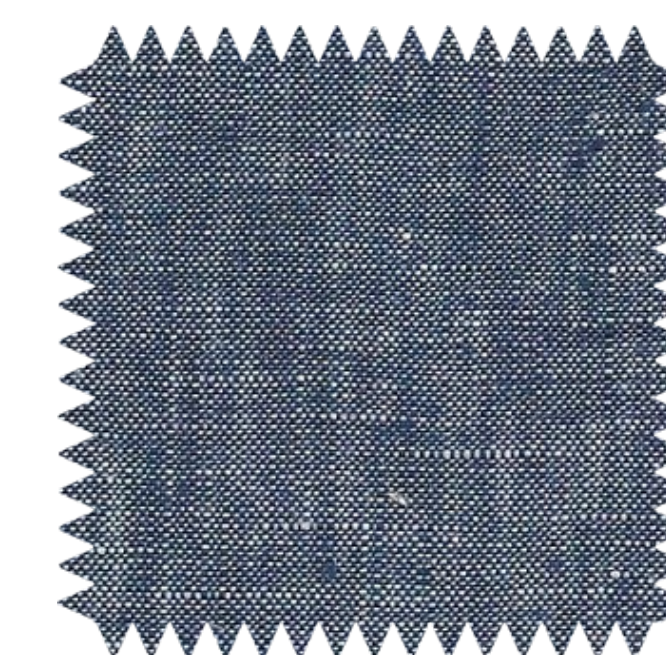
RECYCLED COTTON

When cotton fabric is converted into cotton fibre for reuse in textile products, it becomes recycled cotton. Composed of everything from pre-consumer fabric scraps to used post-consumer products, recycled cotton dramatically reduces textile waste and can partially offset CO2 emissions.



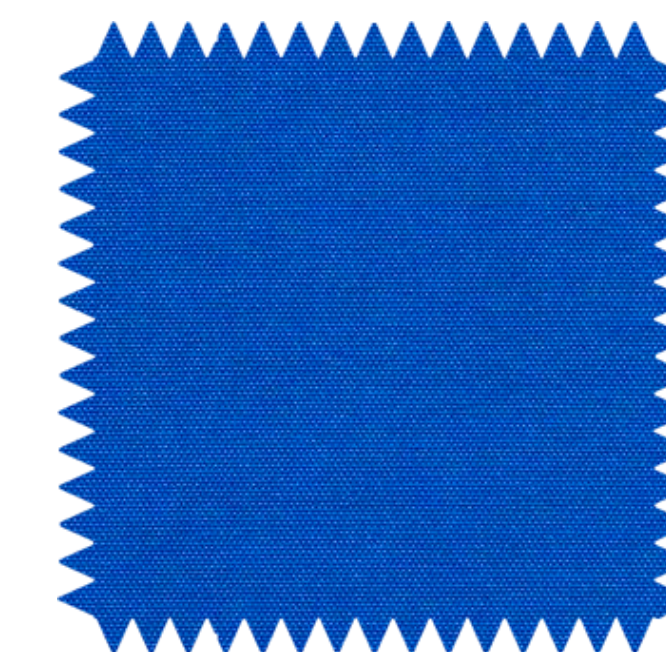
WOOL

A genuinely renewable fibre, wool naturally biodegrades in the soil, slowly releasing nutrients back into the earth. It is 100% natural, highly breathable, and can absorb large quantities of moisture from the body. A huge bonus is that it does not shed microplastics when washed.



LINEN

Linen is derived from the fast-growing flax plant, which thrives without the need for pesticides and has a low water footprint. The hearty flax plant grows on less fertile soil, and its fibres create this fast-drying textile, one of the most robust and durable.



RECYCLED POLYESTER

Recycled polyester has a smaller carbon footprint than virgin polyester and uses less water and energy in the creation process. It is the best option for fashions that require synthetics for performance, like activewear and swimwear.
